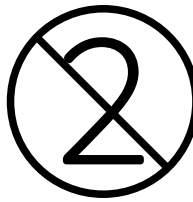

What are Agro Fibres?





Agricultural residue or agro-residue describes all organic material produced as by-products after harvesting and processing agricultural crops. Agro-residues are renewable and a low cost source for natural cellulosic agro fibres.

Aside from their abundance and renewability, using agricultural residues benefits farmers, industry and human health and the environment with potential to:

-  Decrease extensive crop burning and its associated negative effects.
-  Generate new, additional revenue streams for low-income agricultural communities in South and Southeast Asia.
-  Activate a more environmentally sustainable source of fibre for many industries.

Using agricultural residues for industrial purposes is a much more environmentally friendly practice than many residue disposal methods currently in use. Until recently, many farmers disposed of agricultural wastes by burning or landfilling them.
